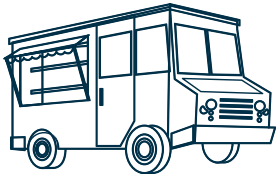

### PLANNING AN ECLIPSE EVENT?

Please call the Environmental Health Office at **937-498-7249** to speak with someone regarding selling food or setting up a temporary campground.



#### FOOD LICENSING REQUIREMENTS

- If you plan to sell food during the eclipse, a food license is required in Ohio.
- Applications for temporary operations are due at least 14 days before the event.

#### CAMPGROUND PERMIT INFORMATION

- If you plan to charge for camping, obtain a permit for a temporary campground as per Chapter 3729 of the Ohio Revised Code. Visit: [Temporary Campground License Application](#)
- Applications for temporary campgrounds are due at least 15 days before the event.

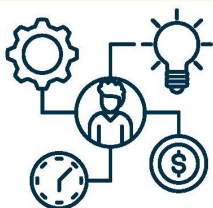
#### SEPTIC SYSTEM AND HAULER INFORMATION

- Avoid parking near septic systems to prevent damage.

#### WATER SOURCES
