GOBA IN SIDNEY JUNE 18-19—LET'S SHOW THEM AN AMAZING SHELBY COUNTY WELCOME!

It's almost GOBA time!!! GOBA is an annual week long bicycle ride organized by Columbus Outdoor Pursuits. Typically participation ranges from 1,000 to 1,250 riders. Participants begin their ride on a Sunday morning, ride 50 miles per day, and overnight (camp) in predetermined cities and towns along an established route.

This year GOBA kicks off in Sidney on Saturday, June 18th for a ride that begins Sunday, June 19th. Guests will camp at the Shelby County Fairgrounds Saturday night and will ride to Jackson Center and back to Sidney the first day. Riders will stay overnight at the Fairgrounds again on Sunday the 19th and then head out to Wapakoneta the morning of the 20th.

NEW POLICY YEAR INSTALLMENTS

The first installment for the new Ohio BWC policy year beginning July 1, 2022 was billed on May 27th and payment is due by June 21, 2022.

Employers can earn a 2% Early Payment Discount by paying their full estimated premium by July 1, 2022. Employers cannot deduct the discount when they submit their payment.

Additionally, please do not submit payment for the first installment until after you have received an invoice.

TRUE-UP ONLINE REPORTING AVAILABLE SOON

The True-up online report will be available on **July 1, 2022**. At the end of the policy year, the BWC must ensure the estimated premium they set for you was correct. To do this, you must file a true-up report that reflects the actual payroll for that policy year. You must complete the report online using the Payroll true-up report service offering by August 15, 2022.

If your true-up payroll exceeds the estimated payroll, you'll owe additional premium. If your true-up payroll is less than your estimated payroll, you'll receive a premium credit. An employer must submit a payroll true-up report even if it has zero payroll.
